The Sabbath-freak finds himself in an extraordinary Sabbath-party between songs like the anti war hymn "War pigs", smashing neck crushers like "NIB", "Sabbath, bloody Sabbath " and sinister masterpieces like "Black Sabbath" as well as all time favs like "Paranoid" and "Iron Man", where the protagonists unleash everything that you expect from a Tribute to Black Sabbath.

The whole thing partly emerged from "OZZMOSIS", Tribute To Ozz, and those who have seen this band can imagine what such a show is gonna be like.
